


Is Your Dog Licensed? *by Ofc. Noreo Gabriel*

Starting August 1, the Town of Prospect will be conducting a door-to-door survey for unlicensed dogs. Anyone found to be in possession of an unlicensed and unvaccinated dog will be subject to a fine. Cats do not have to be licensed, but must be vaccinated for rabies. Dog licenses can


be purchased at the Prospect Town Clerk's office during regular business hours. Proof of current rabies vaccination and spay or neutered dogs must be presented to obtain a license.

Fines for unlicensed dogs is \$75; fine for unvaccinated dogs or cats is \$139.



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Prospect Safety Committee Addresses Rt. 69 Concerns

The individuals shown below met at the Prospect Town Hall on Tuesday, July 22 before boarding a bus to tour Route 69 beginning at the Rt. 68 and 69 junction in the center of Prospect.

Their first concern focused on the entrance to Dunkin' Donuts, which often causes a traffic back-up when drivers attempt to make a left-hand turn into the business.

The CT State Traffic Commission representative agreed that expansion of the right lane would allow drivers the ability to continue traveling north

without needing to climb the right side curb in order to pass a vehicle making that turn.

The group was then driven north to the light at the Hamilton Avenue, Harpers Ferry Road intersection in Waterbury to observe the multiple lane changes that occur as drivers head south towards Prospect.

This photo was taken in the parking lot of Oliver's Supermarket as the group was examining the year 2000 report developed by URS Corporation of Rocky Hill. The report talks about proposed changes to sec-

tions of Rt. 69 from Prospect to Wolcott. An analysis of the group's suggestions and concerns will be forwarded to the CT State Traffic Commission supervisor, John Carey, for his consideration.

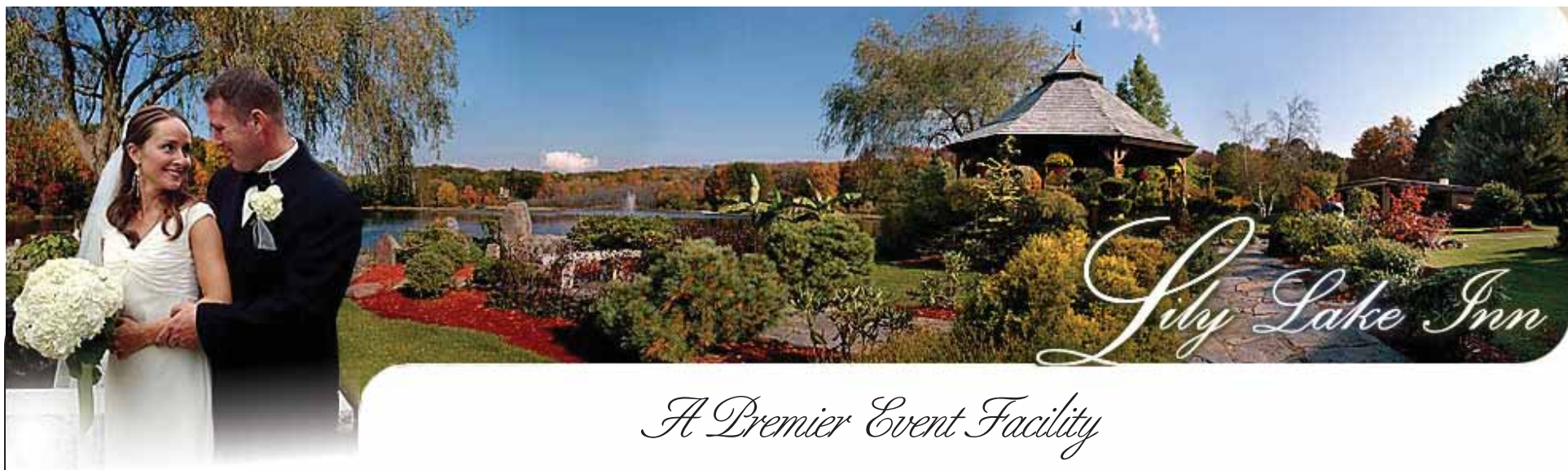
