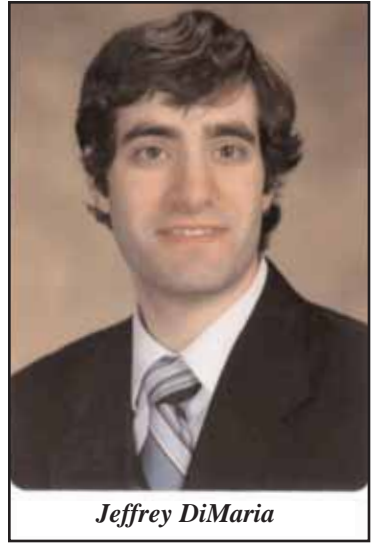

Prospect Man Receives Popular Science Invention of the Year Award

Jeffrey DiMaria, a May graduate of Worcester Polytechnic Institute in Worcester, Massachusetts was selected by Popular Science Magazine as one of 2007's inventors of the year. He and his four teammates developed a new 3D computer mouse as part of their senior project.

The MagicMouse was one of ten inventions awarded the PopSci Invention of the Year Award and was featured in the June 2007 edition of the magazine. The three-dimensional mouse allows the computer user to manipulate items on the computer screen by pointing a finger. The mouse has received a provisional patent.

Jeff received his Bachelor of Science degree with high distinction in Electrical and Computer Engineering with a minor in Physics at Worcester Polytechnic's commencement ceremony in May. He was inducted into Tau Beta Pi the Electrical Engineering Honor Society. He is a member of the IEEE engineering organization and has served as secretary of the school's chapter. He has also been involved in APO, the school's service organization.

Jeff is a graduate of Long River Middle School and Masuk High School. He will be continuing his studies in Electrical and Computer Engineering this fall as a Ph.D. candidate at Boston University. He is the son of John and Rita DiMaria of Prospect.
