We thank Joe Gomez, Wayne Oliver and David Popowski who were the judges this year. We are also happy to print the winning 5th grade essay by Katie P.

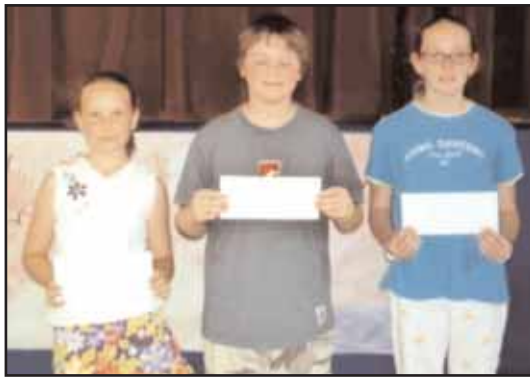
A Better Community

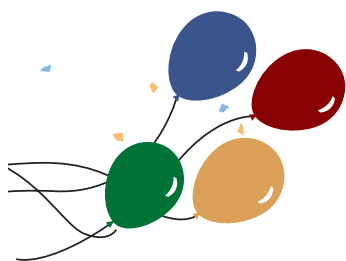

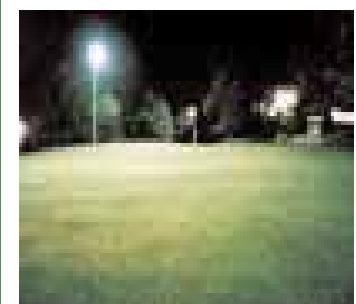
