The Prospect Lions members will be accepting items and will have two drop-off sites over this month and next. Items may be dropped off on Saturday, September 16 at the Golf Tournament, which will be held at Highland Greens Golf Course in Prospect. The club will also be accepting items throughout the day of the next American Red Cross Blood Drive, which will be held on Friday, October 6 at the Prospect Firehouse hall.

Some of the most commonly sent staples include: peanut butter, granola bars, Tic Tacs, oatmeal cream pies, beef jerky, gum, coffee & filters, creamer, juice boxes, fruit snacks, fruit roll-ups, pop-top fruit, tuna & cracker packs, popcorn, pretzels, pudding cups, pop-top ravioli or beefaroni, peanuts/mixed nuts, trail mix, crackers, cookies, mini muffins, dried fruit of all kinds,

candy and chips.

Specialty gift items are appreciated as well, especially around the holidays. The following is a list of suggestions: fly strips, fly swatters, chapstick, baby wipes, Deet bug spray (min. 30 percent), socks, long johns, mittens & gloves, deodorant, shoe insoles, bars of soap, razors, books and DVDs (new or used), white towels & wash cloths, stationery supplies, 100 min. phone cards, sweat bands, cigarettes, chew, sunscreen, disposable cameras.

And finally, medical supplies will certainly help out as well, including Sudafed, Imodium, Tylenol/Motrin, Advil, Aleve, cough drops, cough syrup, Q-tips, migraine meds, Claritin, multi-vitamins, Roloids/Tums, lotion for dry skin, and nail clippers.
